La Bascula is the brainchild of Englishman Ed Adams MW and South African winemaker Bruce Jack. La Bascula focus on wines from all over Spain but the focal point is their Organic Sustainable Terra Alta producers. Le Bascula work with the same producers each year and create their own bespoke blends with them, the emphasis is always on using indigenous Spanish grape varieties

VINEYARDS

Pepe Fuster makes wine from his 28 hectare vineyard in Terra Alta which is near Tarragona in southern Catalonia. Pepe's vineyard is officially certified organic.

The Charge red is made from grapes mainly from the bodega's own vineyards - 70% Tempranillo, 20% Garnacha and 10% Graciano, harvested mid September 2021

The Garnacha vines are nearly 50 years old and this age gives the wine great concentration and complexity of dark, spicy, blackberry fruit which has been seasoned and enhanced by 10 months in the finest new Dargaud & Jaegle oak barrels from France.
